He has practiced plastic surgery for over 30 years and now is serving as International Director of the Brazilian Society of Plastic Surgery (SBCP) and as President-Elect of International Society of Plastic Surgery (ISAPS). He has introduced The Punctiform Technique in the field of Hair Restoration Surgery in the end of the 80s, which still remains the most widely used technique in Baldness Surgery. In 2005 and 2006 published important papers about Platelet Rich Plasma and Platelet Derived-Grow Factors on Hair Restoration. He is the author of numerous publications in important medical journals about Facial and Body Contouring Surgery, as well as several book chapters. Recently has published a paper about Lipoabdominoplasty in the Aesthetic Plastic Surgery Journal. It is one of the coordinators of the International Symposium held every year in São Paulo, a meeting on its 12nd Edition, that brings the renowned Plastic Surgeons of the world to discuss the most recent advances of Plastic Surgery. He receives in his own clinic a great number of surgeons from around the world for training in Plastic Aesthetic and Reconstructive Surgery.

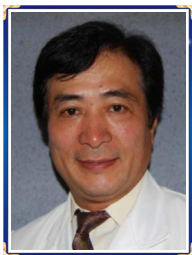

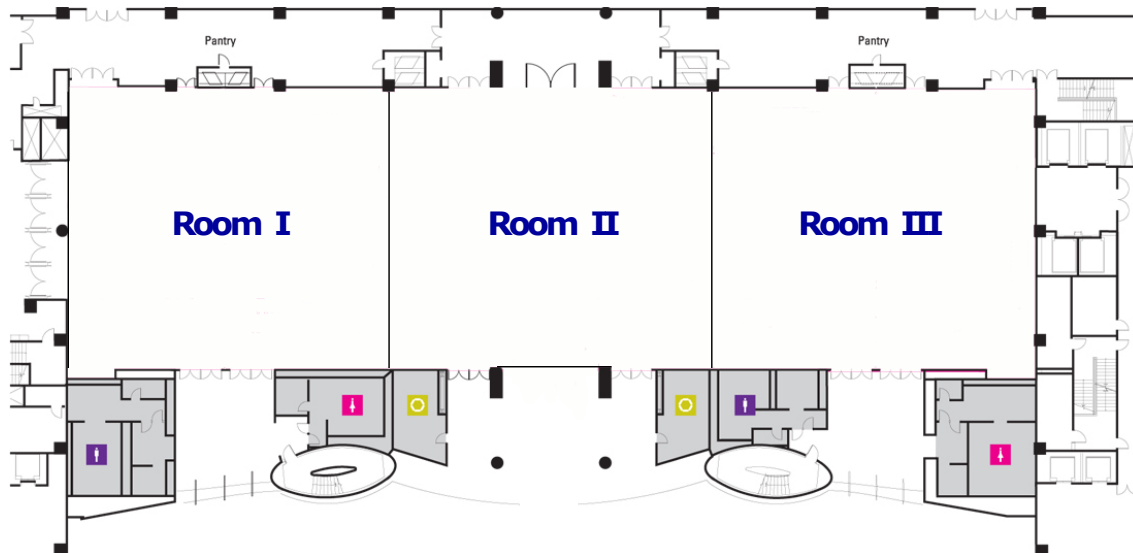

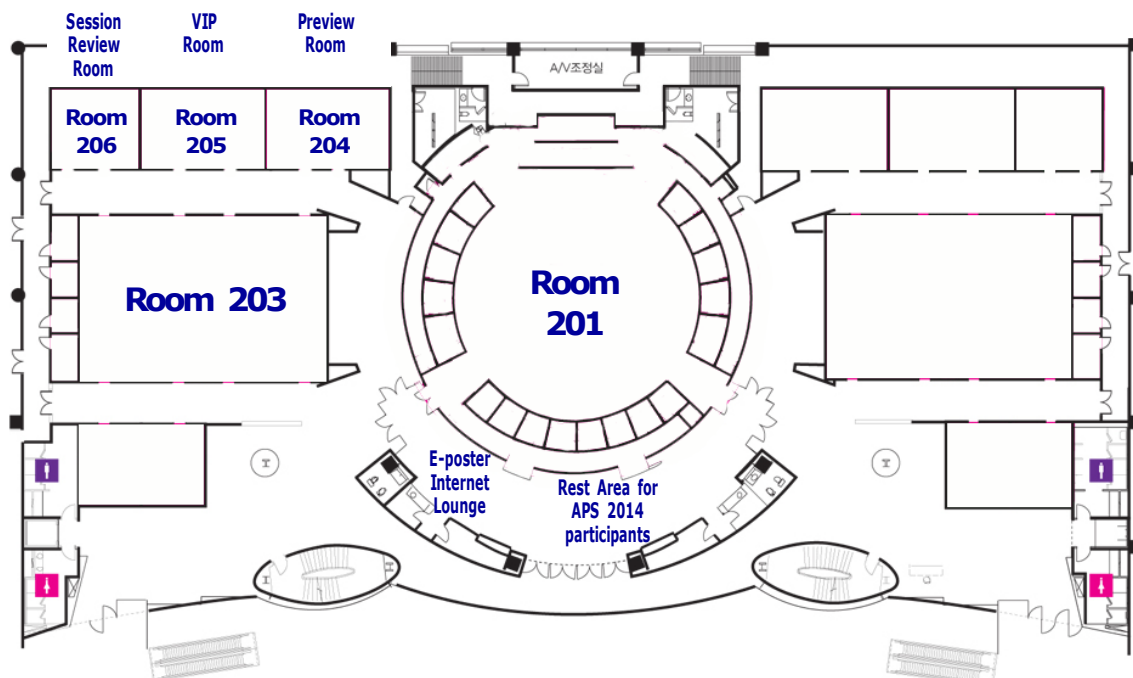

2. A monitor and a mouse will be placed in the podium for the symposium
 - 1) You can use the mouse icon in stead of laser pointer.
 - 2) As presenting the lecture, you can face both the monitor and audience.
 - 3) Please notify staffs beforehand if a laser pointer is needed.
3. All submitted lecture slides will be deleted after the symposium.

◆ Presentation Guideline

1. It is a recommendation to add a simple introduction and conclusion to main content in the lecture. But too much of history and well-known background introduction is better to be omitted.
2. It is desired to present objective information and data with appropriate introduction.
3. An attempt to present excessive graphs and tables in a short time can lead to downgrade the quality of lecture.
4. Exceeding assigned time cannot be tolerated in any circumstances. This is a huge discourtesy to moderators, audience and other speakers. Please practice presentation in advance and measure the length of time. (Microphone will be turned off if the assigned time is over.)
5. Please distribute sufficient time for the audience to understand when a lecture slide is passed on to the next. It will be helpful to add an introduction of main point when observing graphs or photographs.
6. It is suggested to carry under 8 lines of sentences or 2 or less graphics or photographs in a slide. Please enlarge the font into the suitable size.


